RESOLUTION CONTRACTING FOR LEGISLATIVE LOBBYING SERVICES TO REFORM ANNEXATION LAWS

Whereas, the Local Government Alliance, Inc., a non-profit corporation, is willing to provide lobbying services to Townships from across the State of Minnesota in an effort to reform annexation laws; and

Whereas, said Local Government Alliance, Inc. intend on drafting proposed legislation and lobbying the Minnesota Legislature on annexation-related issues; and

Whereas, Carlos Township desires to contract with the Local Government Alliance for lobbying services in an effort to advance the interests of Townships in reforming annexation laws;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Carlos Township Board hereby resolves as follows:

1. The Local Government Alliance shall provide lobbying services in an attempt to reform annexation laws, such services to include drafting legislation, lobbying the Minnesota Legislature, and communicating with Township officers regarding the progress of the lobbying efforts. Said lobbying services shall be provided from September 30, 2001 through June 30, 2002.
2. As consideration for said lobbying services Carlos Township agrees to pay the Local Government Alliance, Inc. a total of \$956.00, calculated at \$.50 per capita of Township population, based upon 2000's population estimate of 1,912.
