

MINUTES
CARLOS TOWN BOARD
November 15, 2012 – Carlos Elementary School

Board Members attending: Dwayne Waldorf, Rod Meyers, Bill Krivanek, Dean Yohnke and Rebecca Anderson. Lowell Jaeger from East Carlos Drive was a guest.

Chairman Waldorf called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of October 25th as printed. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and carried unanimously.

Lowell Jaeger who lives at 8100 East Lake Carlos Drive directed concerns to the board in regard to the snowplowing maintenance. Alden Just was at the meeting and he will address his concerns.

Mr. Jaeger also asked what had happened to all of the road signs. The board explained a federal road study had been compiled and it was determined many signs were not needed. Therefore, under the direction of the township engineer, signs deemed unnecessary were removed.

Road Issues: Alden Just had questions on a few road signs that Jeff Stabnow had suggested be removed. He will touch base with Jeff and confirm the status of those signs.

Miltona and Carlos Townships will again be in agreement in swapping road maintenance for South Miltona Drive and Miltona Bay Road. The road construction on Pike Road is completed.

Rod Meyers moved to pay Alden Just his bill for October, 2012. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Election Update: The Township had 1,500 registered voters as of election day. There were 114 same day registrations with 1,188 people voting, which was a 74% turnout.


Zoning: There was nothing to report.


Committee Reports: Chairman Waldorf attended the ALASD district meeting.
