January 10, 2013 – Carlos Elementary School

Board Members attending: Dwayne Waldorf, Rod Meyers, Bill Krivanek, Dean Yohnke and Rebecca Anderson.

Chairman Waldorf called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Chairman Waldorf led the group with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of December 13, 2012 as printed. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Clerk Rebecca Anderson informed the board that the Board of Canvass can meet directly after the annual meeting on March 12th to verify the election results. It had been conveyed by the county auditor, that the Board could only meet between 3-10 days after the election.
