CARLOS TOWN BOARD
June 26, 2014 – Carlos Elementary School

Board Members attending: Dwayne Waldorf, Rod Meyers, Bill Krivanek, and Rebecca Anderson.

Guest attending: There were none.

Chairman Waldorf called the meeting to order with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of June 5, 2014 as corrected. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Rod Meyers gave a brief recap of the annual Short Course training session.

Road Issues: Mowing is being completed; chloride was applied on Miltona Carlos road in early June. Alden Just will continue to apply the chloride for the township and spray the right of way for noxious weeds.

Drainage Issues: the township has heard from a few residents in which they are having drainage issues. Chairman Waldorf will address these issues with those residents: Laurence Flooding, Three Havens Drive; Tim Nesvold, ELCD; and Rodney Jantzen, CR11.

The board reviewed a Quite Title from Robert Swenson, Tolena Road.

Rod Meyers moved to approve the Petition for Annexation to the City of Alexandria for Michael Thompson. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The board reviewed articles for the July newsletter that will be distributed by the Lakeland Shopper the weekend of July 4th.

The board reviewed building permits for June.

Chairman Waldorf received an anonymous letter from someone indicating an issue in Carlos Bluffs. The board indicated they will not act on any communications that are not signed.
