June 28, 2012 – Carlos Elementary School

Board Members attending: Dwayne Waldorf, Rod Meyers, and Rebecca Anderson. Bill Krivanek was absent

Chairman Waldorf called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Chairman Waldorf led the group with the Pledge of Allegiance.

There is a property on Johnson Road where an approach was added without a culvert. The clerk is to write a letter to that property owner to have them get this installed.

The City of Alexandria will be attending the July 26th Board Meeting to discuss installing water pipe across Carlos Township in the Bay Lane/Tolena Road area by Three Havens.
