

MINUTES
CARLOS TOWN BOARD
June 11, 2015 – Carlos Town Hall

Board Members attending: Dwayne Waldorf, Bill Krivanek, Rod Meyers, Dean Yohnke and Rebecca Anderson, along with township engineer, Jeff Stabnow.

Guest attending: Pam Bradley

Chairman Waldorf called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Due to construction at the Carlos Elementary School, town board meetings will be held at the same time and date, however, the location will be the Town Hall. Notices have been posted and published.

Rod Meyers moved to approve the minutes of May 28, 2015 as printed. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Pam Bradley, who lives on South Riverview Drive is asking the board to install some type of signage for river tubing traffic. The speed limit is 35 miles per hour, however, that doesn't stop drivers from speeding through the neighborhood. She is fearful a child will get hurt due to the excessive speed. The sheriff's office had been called, but they could not ticket anyone, as they did not observe the action. Residents can file a citizen's arrest if needed. The board will post a Local Traffic Only sign at the south entrance to South Riverview.

Road Issues: The board discussed road issues with R&R. There is a lot of brushing to do and they will begin graveling the roads. Alden Just has already applied chloride to gravel roads that do not need gravel.

Bill Krivanek moved to pay R&R their bill for June. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The inslope construction has been completed for Prairie Road. Tradesmens submitted a quote for reseeding. Bill Krivanek moved to accept their quote for reseeding and have them proceed on their time schedule. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Chairman Waldorf will contact Exterior Design in regard to receiving a quote for reseeding Johnson Road.

Bill Krivanek will be working with contractors to obtain quotes for a few blacktop projects the township is looking to repair, ie, Bluffs, Terrace and South Park.

Chairman Waldorf will view the culvert on North Park Road. The right of way at the intersection of ST HWY 29 and South Riverview was also discussed.

Dean Yohnke presented the treasurer's report. Rod Meyers moved to approve the report as presented. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Chairman Waldorf presented expenditures for June. Bill Krivanek moved to pay bills for the amount of \$39,918.62. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

There were no building permits to review.

The annual MAT Short Courses are being held this week and all next week in area towns.

There being no further business, Bill Krivanek moved to adjourn at 9:30 PM. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
