RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ISSUANCE OF AN ON-SALE LIQUOR LICENSE AT CARLOS CREEK WINERY

WHEREAS, Kim and Tammy Bredeson have appeared before the Carlos Town Board requesting consideration of an on-sale liquor license at Carlos Creek Winery

WHEREAS, M.S. 340 A.405 requires the local governing authority to recommend issuance of such a license before the matter can be presented to the County commissioners

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Carlos Town Board personally know the applicants, and the Board is aware of the nature and conduct of the business by the applicants at Carlos Creek Winery


WHEREAS, the applicants are fully informed of the regulations, responsibilities and requirements that are associated with being granted an additional on sale liquor license

NOW THEREFORE, it is


