
The fall newsletter draft was reviewed and will be distributed by the Lakeland Shopper the weekend of November 1<sup>st</sup>.


New business: Rod Meyers received a phone call from a Maple Lane resident regarding adding municipal sanitary sewer. There has been feasibility studies conducted for this area. Residents have indicated the costs were too high for them to consider replacing their septic systems for municipal sewer. If this were to be looked at again, residents from the Maple Lane sub division would have to sign a petition and present it to the township. The township would then petition the ALASD Service Region to perform the study.

Rod Meyers spoke to Larry Steidl and he will remove trees by the public access on East Lake Carlos Drive.
