Board Members attending: Dwayne Waldorf, Rod Meyers, Bill Krivanek, and Rebecca Anderson, along with Township Engineer Jeff Stabnow.

Chairman Waldorf called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Road Issues: Rod Meyers spoke with Corey Groetsch to inform him the board will review the culvert in his driveway when conducting the annual road tour on May 9th.


R&R will be notified of grass gouges and tree removal on Birchwood Road.
