September 28, 2018 – Carlos Elementary School

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of September 13, 2018 as printed. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and it carried.

Committee Reports: The South Lake Miltona Sewer project is finalizing the project. Bill Krivanek moved to charge 2% interest on the sewer assessment. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and it carried. The board also looked at scheduling the assessment hearing for November 1, 2018.

Road Issues:

Chairman Meyers stated the township is on the agenda for October 2nd with the county commissioners to discuss the possibility of the county assisting the township with road maintenance for Pike Road. The road belongs to the township, but is used by residents of the county to access the landfill.

Ida Pines: The road is finished, however, there are shoulder washouts. R&R will be advised to take care of this issue. The board is waiting on Exterior Designs to assist in moderating the in slope on the large curve. By paving the road, the in slope became steeper and the resident cannot mow the right of way.


The board is looking to receive the final bills and hold a hearing on November 1st. The clerk will have the documents available for the next meeting.


Venture Lane. R&R has not started fixing the end of the cul de sac as today.
