Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Meyers indicated the chloride application may be late as Alden Just was having logistic issues in getting the product from Duluth. The culvert was repaired at the end of ELCD cul de sac.

The board of supervisors met with Jerry Hagenmiller, Jeff Stabnow, Corey Groetsch and Darwin Brechbiel on Buckskin East in regard to a drainage issue on Corey Groetsch property. Mr. Groetsch is responsible for any work that he feels needs to be done to remove water from his property as this is a natural drainage pond.

Bill Krivanek moved to accept the quote from ASTECH for sealcoating Carlos Timbers East. Mark Hintermeyer seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The board received an updated feasibility study from Jeff Stabnow for Interlachen Drive/Shady Lane. The clerk will obtain a map and have the board determine the number of parcels before moving forward.

Committee Report: Chairman Meyers sent out sixteen letters to property owners regarding noxious weeds.

The board approved the summary for the South Lake Miltona Sewer project to be published in the Echo Press.
