Road Issues: Calcium Chloride has been applied and the dead end sign at East Lake Carlos Drive will be put back up, as it somehow it was removed.


The board reviewed notes from the annual road tour.


Bill Krivanek moved to approve the alcohol renewal permit for 22 Northmen. Mark Hintermeyer seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
