Regular Meeting, January 28, 2021

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Zoning: Dittberner and Taylor applications approved.

Committee Reports: Bill Krivanek attended an ALASR meeting on line. It appears there isn't much concern regarding salt on the roads, however the concern is water softeners.

Dwayne Waldorf attended the Community Education meeting last week. The district is looking for space for gymnastics and Shenanigans. There is a possibility of adding on to either Woodland or Discovery Schools

Road Issues: Dwayne Waldorf mentioned trees were cut down on private property on Pike Road. At the next meeting, the board will discuss this with R&R.

East Lake Carlos Drive: Township Engineer, Jeff Stabnow presented an updated feasibility estimate. There is still the question if the board can assess residents further south of the proposed construction. This will again be discussed at the February 11th meeting. The board will hold an informational hearing on March 4, 2021 at the Carlos Town Hall.

The board reviewed one building permit.
