

MINUTES
CARLOS TOWN BOARD
June 24, 2021 Carlos Town Hall
Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf and Clerk Rebecca Anderson. Bill Krivanek was absent

Guest attending: Mr. Charlebois.

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, and led the board with reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dwayne Waldorf moved to approve the minutes of June 10, 2021 as printed. Rod Meyers seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Mr. Charlebois attended the meeting with additional information he wanted the board to address. He is stating his neighbors Steve and Stacy Chojnacki have moved a free standing basketball hoop from in front of their house to off the pavement in the township ROW. He feels they are being difficult and childish and would like the township to write them a letter siting statute for this obstruction. Mr. Charlebois is adamant he wants his neighbors to be held responsible for all infractions he feels are viable. The board will view the basketball hoop and see if it is an obstruction. The board has stated this is a neighbor dispute as both parties have retained attorneys.

Zoning: Nothing to report.

Committee reports: Chairman Meyers has been viewing properties for noxious weeds and mailed a notice to the property owner.

Road Issues: The board reviewed quotes from two contractors for the 2021 road projects. The clerk scanned both quotes so all supervisors have this information to study. This issue will be discussed at the next board meeting, when the full board will be in attendance.

The board meeting will be held on July 6, 2021 instead of July 8th, as there are scheduling conflicts. The clerk will post and publish this change in meeting date.

Building permits were reviewed.

Dwayne Waldorf indicated Tom Klemenhausen from Land Team is looking for a letter or minutes indicating the township will be taking over the storm water ponds for Paul Klimek's addition to Stor Smart, along with the developer paying to sealcoat the asphalt road that will be built. Mr. Waldorf will contact Mr. Klemenhausen to see if he found the information on the township's website, as the clerk had spoken with Brian at Land Team in regard to this request.

The board tabled setting a date for the South Lake Miltona Sewer District audit until the July 6th meeting, as Bill Krivanek was absent and he is the liaison for the township.

There being no further business, Dwayne Waldorf moved to adjourn at 8:35 PM. Rod Meyers seconded the motion and it carried.
