CARLOS TOWN BOARD  
February 23, 2023 - Carlos Town Hall  
Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors Rod Meyers, Bill Krivanek, and Dwayne Waldorf along with Clerk Rebecca Anderson.

Guest attending: None.

Chairman Meyers called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of February 9, 2023 as printed. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of February 16, 2023 as printed. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Zoning: Dwayne Waldorf attended the hearing for the applications for Klimek Estates LLC. The board does not have any objections to the conditional use or the plat change. The owners will install one dock with several slips.

Dog Issue: Bill Krivanek had spoken to Mr. Lunak in regard to the letter sent to him involving his roaming dog. The issue was that the dog was off leash for the last few feet to his house and the person making the complaint was afraid the dog would run up onto her property and attack her dog. This was discussed with Mr. Lunak, so he is aware of the situation. Regarding a second letter sent to a resident on Birchwood Road, that dog is under the voice control of the owner, thereby, not violating the township's animal ordinance. Bill Krivanek will address this with the person making the complaint.

Mailbox Issue: The board will look at offering a reduced cost to property owners if they purchase a swing-away post.

Road Issues: Jeff Stabnow presented the board with feasibility studys for Interlachen/Shady Lane and Maple Lane/Frontage. The board ordered an information hearing for Interlachen/Shady Lane for April 11<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM at the Carlos Town Hall. Usually, the board will wait for the project to be ordered, however, since contractors already have the information from previous hearings, they can simply change the costs. Therefore, the board will open bids at 6:30 PM before the hearing.


Jeff Stabnow will also look into costs for East Lake Carlos Drive that has been discussed in the past.
