June 3, 2025 - Carlos Town Hall
Special Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors, Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, and Bill Krivanek along with Clerk, Rebecca Anderson and Treasurer, Tammy Schwegel.

Guests attending: Approximately 450 residents.

The board began to validate voting residents at 6:45 PM. With the large number of residents, it took over an hour before Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 8:10 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek explained why the Special Meeting was called.


Treasurer, Tammy Schwegel recited the purpose of the Special Meeting was to vote to approve an expenditure of up to, but not to exceed 5.7 million dollars for the portion of Carlos Township's responsibility for a new fire hall.


The Special Meeting was posted on May 26th and May 27, 2025 and was published in the Echo Press on May 23rd and May 30, 2025.

There were a few questions from the residents, then the voters were given a ballot.

The ballots were counted by the Carlos Township Board with 26 residents voting YES and ~~346~~³⁹⁰ residents voting NO, indicating the township residents did not allocate up to 5.7 million dollars for the building of the Carlos Fire Hall.

No further business, Bill Krivanek moved to adjourn at 8:30 PM with Dwayne Waldorf seconding the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
