September 11, 2025 - Carlos Town Hall  
Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors, Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, and Bill Krivanek along with Clerk, Rebecca Anderson and Treasurer, Tammy Schwegel.

Guest attending: None

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dwayne Waldorf moved to approve the minutes of August 28, 2025 as corrected. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion which carried.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of September 4, 2025 as corrected. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion which carried.

Road Issues: The board will not be adding any additional gravel as it is getting late in the year. The tree on Bay Lane is in the ROW, therefore R&R will take a look and see if they are able to remove the tree.

Dwayne Waldorf moved to pay R&R's bill for September. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Zoning: The Hintermeister CUP was approved for a gravel pit on Prairie Road. The road for the development by Birchwood Road has been started.

Committee Reports: Dwayne Waldorf gave a brief report on ALASD. Bill Krivanek reported there are issues with the first asphalt lift on Sandhill Lane. This will not be up to the township to repair.

The JPA met on last Monday, September 8<sup>th</sup>. Mike Swensrud attended the meeting and indicated the JPA should begin speaking with area businesses, such as Morton Building or Innovations as they will design a building at no charge.

South Lake Miltona Amendment: There are still changes being made, therefore, this will be tabled until the next meeting.

Road Issues: R&R is to be notified that the frontage road on North Riverview will need to be maintained by the township.

Treasurer's report: Tammy Schwegel presented her report for the financial month ending August 31, 2025. Bill Krivanek moved to approve the report with Dwayne Waldorf seconding the motion which carried unanimously.

Chairman Meyers presented bills for September. Dwayne Waldorf moved to pay bills for the amount of \$48,263.10. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

There were no building permits to review.

There being no other business, Bill Krivanek moved to adjourn at 8:21 PM. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion and it carried.
