

CARLOS TOWN BOARD
February 12, 2026 - Carlos Town Hall
Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors, Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, and Bill Krivanek, Clerk, Rebecca Anderson and Treasurer, Tammy Schwegel.

Guest attending: None

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of January 8, 2026 as printed. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of January 22, 2026 as corrected. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

Road Issues: The board discussed road issues with Dave Luedeke of R&R. The clerk had reviewed the agreement with the County for the road swap for Old CR 120. There is confusion on whether Alexandria or Carlos Township has the road authority for 39th Avenue. Per the drawn agreement, Carlos Township has the north side of the road, and Alexandria has the south side. This is very confusing, as Alexandria Township feels they have authority for the entire road. As far as maintenance goes, Alden Just and R&R have been removing snow – on a whoever gets there first basis. This is unsustainable, for if there are issues on one side, or if there would be an accident, which municipality would be held liable. Carlos Township does not have an issue with having Alexandria Township take over the entire road. Township supervisors will discuss this with the county engineer at the Douglas County Township Association meeting to be held on March 18th.

Dwayne Waldorf moved to pay R&R's bill for February. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Zoning: Central Lakes Storage has a variance that needs to be reviewed. Chairman Meyers will attend the viewing.

Committee Reports: Dwayne Waldorf gave a report on ALASD: Bill Krivanek has not had any ALASR meetings. The JPA will be meeting to get a basic design to show at the Township's Annual meeting to be held on March 10, 2026 for a 2.1 million dollar building.

Clerk, Rebecca Anderson indicated the certified letter went out on Monday Feb 9th in regard to the dog issue on CR 42/Old CR 120.

No other old Business:

Treasurer's report: Treasurer, Tammy Schwegel was given the authority to renew the CD for the South Lake Miltona Sewer District. She presented her financial report for the month ending January 31, 2026.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the report as presented. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion which carried unanimously.


