January 22, 2026 - Carlos Town Hall
Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors, Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, and Bill Krivanek, along with Clerk Rebecca Anderson.

Guest attending: Joey Anderson.

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from January 8, 2026 will be reviewed at the February 12th meeting as the clerk had mistakenly left the township's secured laptop at a hotel. It was being shipped to her and will arrive in the next few days.

Zoning: The planning commission will be holding a hearing on the Pine Have Plat change on January 27th. The township has no concerns with this change.

Joey Anderson addressed the township regarding water drainage on his property on Milona Carlos Road. The water backs up in the spring and ~~runs~~^{can run} over the road. A few years ago, he had the tile jetted out, however it did not last as the tile filled back up with sand. He is hoping for a better fix. He recently had Zacher Excavating out and found out the intake was approximately 10 feet deep. He does not want to fix it this way, as it will be very expensive to trench that deep. There is confusion on who put in an existing tile. Dwayne Waldorf stated he had placed a tile in years ago, however, he had never put in a concrete tile. The amount of water that will flood his property is 100th of an acre. The board will view this in the spring. There may be a cost sharing involved. He is more than happy to find a resolution that will work for both parties.

Committee Reports: Dwayne Waldorf gave a brief report on ALASD.

Fire Hall: Joe Secko lobbied to hire a construction manager, which will need to go out on bids.


