January 8, 2026 - Carlos Town Hall
Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors, Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, and Bill Krivanek, along with Treasurer, Tammy Schwegel. Clerk Rebecca Anderson was attending via Zoom.

Guests attending: None.

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dwayne Waldorf moved to approve the minutes from December 11, 2025 with corrections. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Road Issues: The board went over road issues with Dave Luedeke from R&R.

Bill Krivanek moved to pay R&R the bill for January. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Zoning: There is a plat request for two residents on Emerald Drive. The township does not have any issues with this change, therefore, the clerk will inform Land and Resources that there is no opposition from the township.

Committee Reports: A special JPA meeting was called for the Fire Hall. The city had eliminated property in town that the JPA had been looking at to build the fire hall vs the school site. The City of Carlos had wanted to build downtown, however, the township is not interested in purchasing property.

JPA is having a meeting on Monday, January 12th. Commissioner Jerry Rapp had indicated to some residents that there would be a vote, however, there is nothing to vote on at this time. Dave Kjos will contact and inform the Commissioner of this.

Todd Powers has agreed to remain the township's representative for AAEDC.

The clerk had sent out a letter to a resident on CR 42 regarding his dog roaming. The clerk is to send another letter – certified. The letter will indicate the sheriff will become involved if the dog continues to roam.

No other old business:

Road Issues: The clerk is to order a new sign for Hidden Oaks Dr.




No building permits were reviewed. Dwayne Waldorf will check on who picks up dead deer on township or county roads.
