November 13, 2025 - Carlos Town Hall
Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors, Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, Bill Krivanek along with Clerk, Rebecca Anderson and Treasurer, Tammy Schwegel.

Guests attending: Scott Elwood, Tori Marion.

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of October 23, 2025 with a correction. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Tori Marion is with SBA Disaster Relief. She presented the board with a flyer indicating that property owners can apply for disaster relief funds. The clerk will place this information on the township's website.

Road Issues: R&R has completed blading for the year. The clerk had received a bill from R&R for lumpy sealcoating that had to be removed from North Riverview. R&R will bill Jeff Stabnow for this removal. She will also look to see if the township has paid for any other removal of excess sealcoating debris removed from North Riverview.

Dwayne Waldorf moved to pay R&R's bill for November. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

South Lake Miltna Sewer District. Scott Elwood reported he had completed his inspection of the system all systems were working properly. He did not have any call out this past summer. He has a list of tanks that will need to be pumped. There is one property that he need to spend more time on once it is pumped as the resident appears to be misusing the system. He will speak with the owner about how to manage his tank.

The board will have Alden Just spray the thistles next year on the mound. Scott did mow the mound system twice this year. There is no deterioration with the tanks and there is plenty of capacity on the system. Tony Cardinal received permit for a holding tank through the county. The board is waiting to hear back from Dave Rush on how to proceed with the amendment for changes/additions to the district.

Zoning: Dwayne Waldorf attended the viewing for the plat change for the Juettner application. There are two owners - one on either side of an empty lot. The application is to split the empty lot and divide it into 2, therefore, each owner would have a larger lot. Thus 3 lots reduced to 2. The township does not have any concerns with this application.

Committee Reports: The JPA will be receiving a presentation from Ringdahl Architects for the fire hall. The JPA would also like ways to get information out to the property owners involved

with this project. The clerk will post information along with already posting minutes from each JPA meeting on the township's website.

Dwayne Waldorf gave a brief report on ALASD.

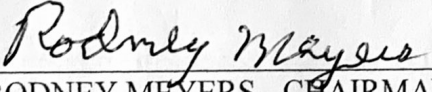
No other old business.

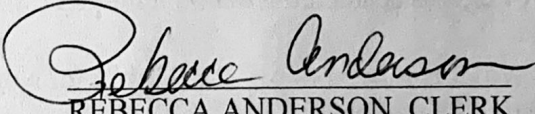
