Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors, Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, and Bill Krivanek and Clerk, Rebecca Anderson.

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes of March 12, 2026 as printed. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

Zoning: Dwayne Waldorf attended the zoning meeting for the application of DA Investments LLC. The building will be for used for installing docks and lifts. The application also is requesting two signs that would be placed on the roof of the building which is located at the corner of CR 13 and State Hwy 29.

Committee Reports: A resident of Carlos Township is working on her own to find funding for the proposed building of the Fire Hall. Ringdahl was paid out of the JPA funds for the conception drawings.

Recap of the Douglas County Association of Township meeting: Department heads from the county presented information regarding upcoming road projects, disaster relief, property taxes, and upcoming Board of Equalization hearings. Dave Rush gave a lengthy report on garbage hauling and if anything can be done to assist the township is reducing wear and tear on roads. The issue of which township, (Carlos or Alexandria) is responsible for 39th Avenue. Carlos Township will permit to have Alexandria take over the entire road vs both townships maintaining the North and South lanes of the road respectively.

Road Issues: Going forward, when a resident calls in regarding a broken mailbox, due to snowplow damage, the clerk is to contact a township supervisor. The supervisor will contact the resident and if warranted, will contact the township's road maintainer. Chairmen Meyers will check with Alden Just to confirm he can pick up the sand on the roads on days that will eliminate extensive dust.


The Annual Road Tour will be held April 25, 2026 at 8:00 AM.
