April 23, 2026 - Carlos Town Hall
Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors, Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, and Bill Krivanek along with Clerk, Rebecca Anderson.

Guest attending: None.

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes from April 9, 2026 with corrections. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

Bill Krivanek moved to approve the minutes from the Board of Equalization, April 16, 2026. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

Zoning: Nothing to report.

Committee Reports: Fire Meeting – The City of Carlos has agreed to pay the upfront cost for the township for the design of the fire hall. This process will take up to two months. The City will want to be reimbursed. The agreement has changed, therefore, there are questions for the attorney on how to amend the Joint Powers Agreement document.

ALASR: The board needs to look at Sandhill Lane/Terrace along with Ida Pines to make sure there are not any problems with these roads as ALASD is finishing the project.

The board reviewed the draft for the Annual Meeting minutes held on March 10, 2026, as some residents wanted this to be posted on the township's website before the next annual meeting (which is customary) to be held in March of 2027.

Road Issues: The board discussed the upcoming road tour that will take place on Saturday, April 25th starting at 8:00 AM, along with the clerk indicating she had heard from one of the three residents who had agreed the township could perform brushing along a section along Old County RD 42.

Other Old Business: There are more complaints from residents in regard to roaming dogs along with a chicken coop and chickens that have not been permitted by the restaurant Interlachen on CR 42. The board will look at this on the road tour.

No further new business, Bill Krivanek moved to adjourn at 8:01 PM. Dwayne Waldorf seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
