

CARLOS TOWN BOARD
April 9, 2026 - Carlos Town Hall
Regular Meeting

Board Members attending: Supervisors, Rod Meyers, Dwayne Waldorf, and Bill Krivanek along with Clerk, Rebecca Anderson and Treasurer, Tammy Schwegel.

Guest attending: David Kjos.

Chairman Meyers called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dwayne Waldorf moved to approve the minutes of March 26, 2026 as corrected. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion that carried unanimously.

Road Issues: The board discussed snowplowing road issues with Dave Luedeke from R&R.

Dwayne Waldorf moved to pay R&R. Bill Krivanek seconded the motion which carried unanimously.

Zoning: There are no viewings for the township.

Committee Reports: Dwayne Waldorf gave a brief report on the ALASD meeting. Bill Krivanek will be attending the ALASR meeting on April 15, 2026.

The JPA will be meeting on Monday, April 13th.

David Kjos discussed brushing that is needed on Old CR 120 as it is getting to be a public safety issue. The clerk will send out letters to three (3) property owners to get permission to brush up to six (6) feet off of road surface which would include the property past the Theater Le Homme Diu Theater to the Lea Hedine property lines.

Bill Krivanek noted the township will be combining the fire levies for both the Alexandria and Carlos Fire Departments together. Therefore, all of Carlos Township residents will be paying for the fire hall. If the City of Carlos agrees to pay the upfront cost for the fire hall design and if the bids come in at ^{less} .25% of the overall Carlos Township's ^{taxable} market value, the fire hall can be built without a referendum.

The board went over corrections for the minutes from the Annual Meeting held March 10, 2026. The minutes can then be posted as a Draft of Annual Minutes on the website.

The board discussed issues discussed at the State Conference held March 27th.


New Business: The annual road tour will be held on Saturday, April 25th at 8:00 AM
